- c. **Policy 7551: Naming Facilities:** An opportunity to create and discuss a naming of facilities policy.
- d. **Policy 6172.1: Gifted and Talented Students Program:** (NEW) *Not later than July 1, 2022, each local and regional board of education shall adopt a policy for the equitable identification of gifted and talented students. Such policy shall require the use of multiple methods of identification of gifted and talented students that are in compliance with guidance provided by the Department of Education.*
- e. **Policy 6146.12: Challenging Curriculum Policy:** (NEW). *(a) Not later than July 1, 2022, each local and regional board of education shall adopt a challenging curriculum policy. A challenging curriculum policy shall include, but need not be limited to, (1) criteria for the identification of students in grades eight and nine who may be eligible to take or enroll in an advanced course or program, as defined in section 3 of this act, and (2) a provision requiring the creation of an academic plan, in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b) of this section.*
