    - a. <u>Policy 6146.1</u>: Grading/Assessment Systems: Weighted Grades: Addresses updates and defines practices in accordance with <u>PA 21-199</u>, § 3, Advanced Course Enrollment and Public Act 21-2, Automatic Admissions Program Eligibility, on:

- b. <u>Policy 5132</u>: Student Dress Code: An opportunity to review our Student Dress Code Policy. Additionally, here is each school's <u>Parent Handbook information regarding Dress Code</u>
  - i. Proposed NPS dress code policy 5132

The committee discussed student dress code and the many factors involved in this topic, including, but not limited to, body shaming and sexualization. Following this discussion and review of the policy, the committee made recommended changes. These recommendations were voted on and unanimously approved to go forward to the full Board for review and discussion on May 25 2022 and vote on June 6, 2022.

- c. <u>Policy 7551</u>: Naming Facilities: An opportunity to create and discuss a naming of facilities policy.
  - The committee agreed to the recommended changes. These recommendations were voted on and unanimously approved to go forward to the full Board for review and ultimately, approval.
- d. Policy 6172.1: Gifted and Talented Students Program: (NEW) Not later than July 1, 2022, each local and regional board of education shall adopt a policy for the equitable identification of gifted and talented students. Such policy shall require the use of multiple methods of identification of gifted and talented students that are in compliance with guidance provided by the Department of Education.

  The committee discussed gifted and talented identification and programs, and the many factors involved in this topic. Following this discussion and review of the policy, the committee made

recommended changes. These recommendations were voted on and unanimously approved to go forward to the full Board for review and discussion on May 25 2022 and vote on June 6, 2022.

e. Policy 6146.12: Challenging Curriculum Policy: (NEW). (a) Not later than July 1, 2022, each local and regional board of education shall adopt a challenging curriculum policy. A challenging curriculum policy shall include, but need not be limited to, (1) criteria for the identification of students in grades eight and nine who may be eligible to take or enroll in an advanced course or program, as defined in section 3 of this act, and (2) a provision requiring the creation of an academic plan, in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b) of this section.

The committee discussed the challenging curriculum, and the many factors involved in this topic. Following this discussion and review of the policy, the committee made recommended changes. These recommendations were voted on and unanimously approved to go forward to the full Board for review and discussion on May 25 2022 and vote on June 6, 2022.

f. Policy 6141.51: Advanced Courses (New)

The committee discussed advanced courses and the many factors involved in this topic. Following this discussion and review of the policy, the committee made recommended changes. These recommendations were voted on and unanimously approved to go forward to the full Board for review and discussion on May 25 2022 and vote on June 6, 2022.
